Button Turtle Craft

Description: Use a recycled CD to make an adorable turtle, while working on your child's fine motor skills.

Recommended Ages: PreK – 2nd

Materials:

- CD
- Buttons
- School Glue
- Green construction paper
- Scissors
- Markers
- Optional: Clear tape

Procedure:

1. Using your marker, trace out the turtle's head, legs, and tail. You will need one large half oval, four smaller half ovals, and a triangle. Cut out your shapes.
2. Use either clear tape or glue to attach your turtle's head, legs, and tail to your recycled CD on the top side, leaving the bottom (or shiny) side up.
3. Spread school glue all over the shiny side of the CD, which will be your turtle's shell.
4. Stick buttons onto the glue, creating your own pattern and design!
5. Use marker to draw eyes and a mouth on your turtle.
6. Let dry for 24 hours.
