I am going the Holiday Art Fair at the Midland Center for the Arts. An art fair is a place where we can buy items from local artists!

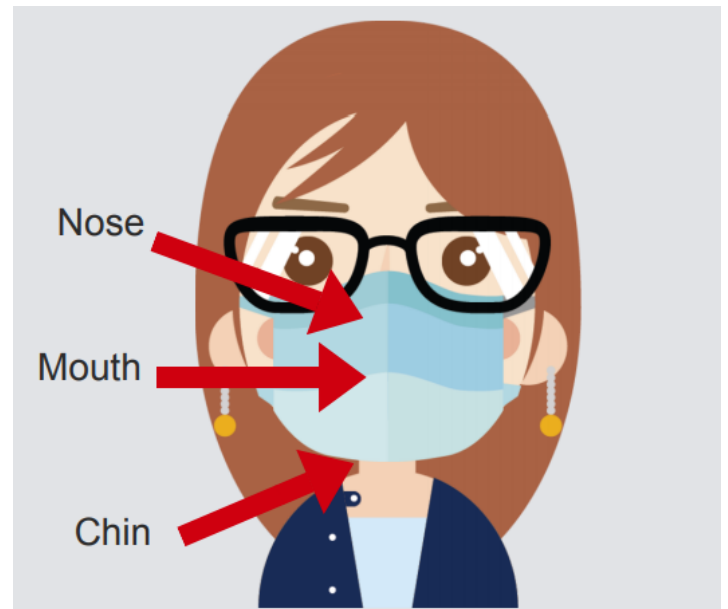
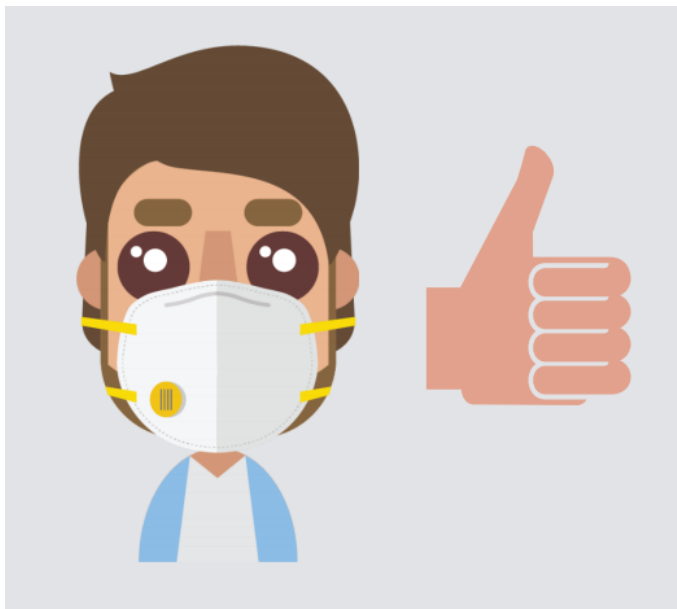


This is the parking lot at the Midland Center for the Arts. We will get out of our car here and walk to the doors.
